Sulcis-Iglesiente is one of the oldest territories in all of Sardinia. The Lu' Hotel Carbonia offers you excursions that will let you discover ancient treasures, including the geo-mining heritage that you can explore by entering the heart of the earth and becoming heirs of a World Heritage Site.



You will be able to discover ancient Nuragic, Phoenician, Roman and Byzantine archaeological sites or be amazed by the beauty of the numerous caves which every year attract thousands of visitors from all over the world.



Sea and Nature

Porto Pino Beach is one of the most beautiful pearls of the Mediterranean, famous for its white sand dunes and a sea whose colors change from emerald green to turquoise to blue.



The beach is set between lagoons and a pine forest made up of Aleppo pines, thorny oaks, junipers and lush Mediterranean scrub. The coast of Porto Pino offers shallow water which makes it particularly accessible to children. A short distance away you can reach the beach of Francesi, a crescent of very fine white sand with shells and coral fragments.

Sport

The Lu' Hotel Porto Pino is the ideal destination for those who want a beach holiday but don't want to give up the practice of sport. The hotel has a swimming pool, multi-purpose tennis and soccer field, electric bicycle rental, ping pong table.



Within a short distance it is possible to practice all water sports such as diving, kite surfing, snorkelling, deep-sea fishing and sailing. Culture

In the village of Sant'Anna Arresi stands an ancient nuraghe, famous for its position in the heart of the city, close to two churches dedicated to the patron saint. The prehistoric site dates back to the 15th-14th century BC. (Middle Bronze Age).



A short distance away you can reach the grandiose necropolis of Montessu, Le Domus de Janas (fairy houses). Sant'Anna Arresi also represents the starting point of a food and wine itinerary not to be missed. Flavors and traditions of Sardinia meet in this corner of paradise.

A short distance from the Lu' Hotel Porto Pino it will be possible to visit fragrant vineyards and ancient cellars producing the "Carignano", a fine wine from the Sulcis-Iglesiente region.

Culture

Sant'Antioco stands on the ruins of Sulki, one of the oldest cities in the western Mediterranean. Built in 770 BC by the Phoenicians, it was one of the most prosperous cities in Sardinia under Roman rule.



The island has important archaeological evidence from the Nuragic and pre-Nuragic periods such as the menhirs, the tombs of the giants and the tophet, which make Sant'Antioco one of the most visited cultural destinations in Sardinia. Sant'Antioco and Calasetta are the main inhabited centers of the island with their marinas full of numerous clubs, pizzerias, bars, ice cream parlors, whose evenings are enlivened by cultural events, shows and concerts.

Sea

The coast of the island of San Pietro is a succession of white coves bathed by crystal clear waters and dark cliffs overlooking the sea: a blue paradise of relaxation.



A short distance from the Lu' Hotel Riviera, you will find pristine beaches, protected by verdant and fragrant Mediterranean scrub. All the beaches are easily reachable from the hotel by public transport or with your own car.



Nature

Around Carloforte nature reigns supreme. A short distance from our hotel it is possible to reach still virgin territories characterized by cliffs overlooking the sea and deep inlets where scents and colors meet.



The LIPU Oasis is famous, characterized by a variety of flora and fauna including numerous species that have led to the classification of the area as an "International Interest Area".

Culture

The only inhabited center on the island of San Pietro, Carloforte is part of the circuit "The most beautiful villages in Italy". Colonized in 1738 by Genoese from the Tunisian islet of Tabarka, it preserves the traditions and the Ligurian dialect intact.



Lu' Hotel Riviera is located in the heart of the town, between arches and narrow streets ("the caruggi") you will discover that here the Sardinians speak Genoese and the doors of the house are left open without fear. There are numerous events linked to cultural, artistic and food and wine traditions. The calendar of events is also full of shows and concerts.
